Our Quality Technician is responsible for the inspection and testing of products at various stages of production to ensure that the product quality and customer specification criteria are maintained. The position will work with a variety of test equipment and methods for the inspection of processes and products.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Inspect parts as defined in the QA procedures and work instructions
- Visually identify defects
- Inspect parts to meet specifications and output levels
- Perform sample inspections and tests of components to ensure product requirements
- Use inspection equipment including, but not limited to, micrometer, calipers, height gauge, bore gauge
- Use of Coordinate Measuring Machines (CMM) for product inspections
- Keeps laboratory supplies ready by inventorying stock, placing orders, verifying receipt
- Recognize and report any safety issues
- Document and be knowledgeable of job-related Quality Management System
- Maintain accurate quality records of inspections and rejections
- Provide support to the manufacturing team on control of non-conform material and potential quality issues
- Follow up on non-conformance rejection
- Perform containment actions as needed (sorting, inspections, etc.)
- Any other tasks as assigned by your supervisor
