Responsible for precision CNC Machine set-up, and first piece runs, prototype parts, and production components working with various hard metals on our 5 axis DMG Mori machines in a state-of-the-art facility.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Meet and sustain established quality and production volume performance criteria
- Work to job prints, drawings, specs, and work instructions to produce components
- Set up and/or break down basic equipment, fixtures, and tooling
- Utilize pressure-regulated air hoses; Deburr parts and edges to specifications
- Use CNC equipment to manufacture simple and complex components having interrelated dimensions and compound angles
- Produce components within required tolerances according to prints, designs, and specifications
- Use precision measuring instruments (ex. micrometers, calipers, etc.)
- Maintain accurate dimensional tolerances based upon work instructions
- Record job time accurately for daily work and neatly complete production forms as required
- Rework and calibrate components as required; continuously check for accuracy
- Train, document, guide, and assist others to meet quality specifications and standards for customer expectations
- Ensure all required documentation is completed at each stage of production
- Assure all work areas are safely maintained, clean, and organized
- Performs other duties as assigned

Skills:

- Significant experience with CNC machining and tooling setup (requires at least 5 years' experience)
- Knowledge of tooling, deburring tools, and manual gauges
