



Quality Technician

Responsible for the inspection and testing of products at various stages of production to ensure product accuracy and precision through meticulous measurement and inspection processes. The position will work with a variety of test equipment and methods of measurement and inspection of processes and products.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform precise measurements and inspections of products using various metrology tools and equipment.
- Interpret technical drawings and specifications to ensure compliance with quality standards.
- Conduct product and material receiving inspections, verifying certifications against standards and specifications.
- Document and report measurement results, identifying any deviations from specifications visually or using CMM reports.
- Collaborate with production and engineering teams to address quality issues and implement corrective actions.
- Maintain a clean and organized work environment, adhering to safety protocols.
- Keeps laboratory supplies ready by inventorying stock, placing orders, verifying receipts
- Document and be knowledgeable of job-related Quality Management System
- Follow up on non-conformance rejection
- Perform containment actions as needed (sorting, inspections, etc.)

Preferred Skill Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent; technical degree or certification in metrology or a related field is preferred.
- Proven experience as a Quality Technician in a manufacturing or industrial setting.
- Proficiency in using measurement tools such as calipers, micrometers, CMMs, and other precision instruments.
- Strong understanding of technical drawings, blueprints, and GD&T (Geometric Dimensioning and Tolerancing).
- Excellent attention to detail and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Strong communication and documentation skills.

Education, Experience and Requirements:

Physical Demands:
